

GOLD MEDAL PRESENTED TO EACH MEMBER OF THE STELLENBOSCH COMMANDO TEAM (Sergeant du Plessis, Captain Greeff and Staff Sergeant Kotze) FOR WINNING FIRST PRIZE IN THE **SENTRY GROUP COMPETITION AT THE 1978 SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP FOR ALL WESTERN PROVINCE ARMY UNITS WITH 65 TEAMS COMPETING.**) The Sentry Group Competition takes place over a distance of 100 meters: An antelope target pops up, moves to the right for six seconds for scoring hits, and then drops away, leaving twenty 30 x 30cm steel plates standing on the butt, with ten seconds left to flatten them.

MEDALS PRESENTED TO MR JAN SMUTS GREEFF OF KIMBERLEY: THE FIRST FOR WINNING THE BISLEY COMPETITION AT JACOBSDAL, CONTESTED BETWEEN TEAMS FROM KIMBERLEY AND JACOBSDAL IN 1947, AND THE SECOND FOR WINNING THE BISLEY CHAMPIONSHIP IN KIMBERLEY IN 1949, CONTESTED BY TEAMS FROM ALL OVER GRIQUALAND WEST. (This event was witnessed by his son, Gabriel Johannes Greeff, two months prior to his seventh birthday.)
